Baking Soda Volcano

Material

- 6 cups flour
- 2 cups salt
- 4 tablespoons cooking oil
- 2 cups warm water
- plastic soda bottle
- dishwashing detergent
- food coloring
- vinegar
- baking dish or another pan
- 2 T baking soda

Directions

- 1. Mix flour, salt, cooking oil, and water to create a dough-like mixture. It should be smoothand firm, add more water if needed.
- 2. Stand the empty soda bottle in the baking pan and mold the dough into a volcano shape.
- 3. Fill the bottle most of the way with warm water and a bit of red food coloring.
- 4. Add 6 drops of detergent to the bottle contents. The detergent helps trap the bubbles produced by the chemical reaction, so you get better lava.
- 5. Add baking soda to the liquid.
- 6. Slowly pour vinegar into the bottle, and then watch out it's eruption time!
