

CHILD WELLNESS POLICY

Kids Quest Policy:

Children may not enter the center if they have experienced any of the following symptoms or conditions listed below over the past 72 hours:

- A fever or high temperature, when taken via auxiliary methods (temporal screening), is at or over 100.4 degrees,
 - Has not taken any fever-reducing medication within the past 24 hours, such as Tylenol/ Acetaminophen, Advil/ Ibuprofen, Motrin, Aleve, cold/flu medicine, etc.
- Severe diarrhea or frequent watery stools,
- Vomiting,
- Acute symptoms of a cold or drainage from the eyes,
- Significant respiratory distress, including severe cough or difficulty breathing,
- Chills, including repeated shaking with chills,
- An undiagnosed rash or rash attributable to a contagious illness or condition,
- Muscle pain,
- Headache,
- Sore throat,
- Loss of taste or smell, or
- Signs of any other contagious disease; for example, chicken pox, mumps, strep throat, pink eye, flu, impetigo, scabies, lice, etc.

Kids Quest Response Plan, If Observed While in Our Care:

- If any of the above conditions exist, the child will be isolated from other children and placed under appropriate supervision.
- Our manager on duty will notify parent/legal guardian immediately after child is safely isolated.
- Our manager on duty will discuss with parent/legal guardian our concerns and in some cases, the child may have to be removed from the center.
- Our team will follow up in accordance with Kids Quest's cleaning and sanitation guidelines.

By signing below, I certify that my child has not had any of the symptoms mentioned above over the past 72 hours and is well enough to enter in the center.

I understand and agree to allow my child(ren)'s temperature to be taken by a Kids Quest staff member prior to entering the center, and that it may be taken while in the center.

Further, I agree to be responsive to telephone calls, text or email messages from Kids Quest staff regarding my child(ren)'s wellness during their stay at the center.
