HEALTH AND SAFETY AT KIDS QUEST AND CYBER QUEST

Our top priority will always be the health and safety of our employees, our guests, and the children entrusted to our care. Before you visit, be advised of the following changes at our centers.

Effective midnight Friday, June 25, 2020, the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and under the advisement of Station Casinos, all children ages 10 and older will be required to wear face masks upon visiting any Station Casino property including while visiting our Kids Quest and Cyber Quest locations.

08/14/20 Update: All children over the age of 5 must wear a face mask to attend Kids Quest, per Nevada child care licensing guidance, and Governor Sisolak's emergency directive no. 28. If your child has a medical condition that exempts them from wearing a face mask, documentation from a medical provider must be shown to a member of Kids Quest staff upon check-in. Children under the age of 2 will not be required to wear face masks.

FACE MASKS REQUIRED

Face masks are required for all children five years and older at Kids Quest. Face masks are required for all guests ten years and older at Cyber Quest. This includes those who are vaccinated and not vaccinated alike.



INCREASED CLEANING AT CENTERS

Our employees have increased cleaning within our centers and will be closing off areas of the center rotationally to ensure frequently touched surfaces are properly disinfected.



PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING During

check in/checkout, please maintain a 3 foot distance from those around you to allow for social distancing.



DAILY TEMPERATURE SCREENING (KIDS QUEST ONLY)

Before entering the center children will be required to stop at our temperature check station. If your child's temperature reading exceeds 100.4 – your child will be denied entry. This is to ensure we are providing a safe play environment for our employees and other quests.



WASH HANDS FREQUENTLY

Hand washing will be required before you or your child will be able to play.
